Minutes of the IQAC Meeting held on 26th May 2018

- Dr. Bhavna Dave, coordinator of IQAC that various action plans were listed in the
 previous meetings and targets set were achieved too. However a detailed criterion-wise
 perspective plan needs to be chalked out so that all areas for quality improvement are
 covered. After discussion, the various criterion given by NAAC were distributed amongst
 the B.Ed. & M.Ed. faculty members keeping in mind the portfolios they handled in college
 and each one was told to list their plan of action and give the document to the IQAC
 Coordinator.
- Dr. Bhavna Dave informed the committee that Dr. Geeta R. Thakur had given her resignation and was serving in the notice period.
- The IQAC members discussed the need of accelerating the functioning of the Pillai Education Alumni Association. Principal Dr. Sally told the members that she was happy that the association was registered. The alumni members in the IQAC- Ms. Suchitra and Mr. Rajesh said that they had planned to work actively for the community. Some of the alumni will also be contacted to conduct sessions for the current batch of students. These sessions could help develop teaching skills of the students. They would also give their plan of action after discussion in the Pillai Education Alumni Association meeting.
- It was also decided that IQAC coordinator and other members contact the heads of various institutions that would help us in enhancing quality and sign a Memorandum of Association with them. Dr. Bhavna said that the MoU signed with MGM nursing college was functional & very helpful. They helped the college to conduct a certificate course on Basic first aid and also sought help from our faculty members to take sessions on Evaluation for their students.
- It was decided in the meeting that a certificate course on 'Understanding the Self' should
 be introduced for the B.Ed. students. Better self-awareness will help them to build high
 self-esteem and confidence in the students. The course units would be listed in the staff
 meeting and conducted by the staff members.
- The College Ph.D. centre had 5 research guides and therefore date for interviews should be scheduled, panelists invited and the applicants must be sent mails informing the date, time and venue of interviews.
- Teacher-educators were encouraged to make efforts to publish research based papers in peer-reviewed journals and also guide students to take up research activities other than compulsory in the curriculum.

- The committee discussed that the paper-bag project should be boosted so that more vendors can get the benefit of receiving bags for free. It would also help to minimize the use of plastic bags.
- The IAQC discussed that since we organize two seminars every year, students should be motivated to use this as a platform to present papers. This will not only enhance their knowledge about research, the style of presentation and other topics but also give them confidence of public speaking.
- The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.

Minutes of the IQAC Meeting held on 1st September 2018

- Dr. Bhavna Dave informed the members that the College Ph.D. Centre had received many applications from candidates willing to register for Ph.D. The college had 5 vacant seats for Ph.D. candidature for which interviews have to be planned.
- She also informed the members that a National level seminar on "Environmental Re-Engineering Series- 9: Clean & Green Planet" was planned to be organized on 1st December 2018. This seminar would be a student-special seminar in which students would be encouraged to present papers-both conceptual and research-based which would be guided by the students. All
- She put in a proposal to the committee for signing a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to promote and enhance mutual cooperation of academic interest between our college and K.M.E. Society's G.M. Momin Women's College at the seminar on 1st December. The IQAC team unanimously agreed as everyone was of the opinion that this MoU will help to provide advice and expertise for promote curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities between both institutes. IOAC Coordinator Dr. Bhavna Dave Minutes of the IQAC Meeting held on 5th January 2019

- Dr. Bhavna Dave informed the members that the College Ph.D. Centre had called the applicants for Ph.D. candidature for interviews on 13th December, 2018. Five seats that were vacant were taken up by the different guides as per the merit list after the interviews.
- Four faculty members participated in the UGC sponsored FDP on "Education in Universal Human Values" from 17th to 23rd Dec. 2018 organized by HRDC, Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune at Baha'i Academy, Panchagani and Principal Sally Enos will also be attending a three-day workshop on the same theme from 15th to 17th Feb. 2019.
- It was also discussed that since all faculty members were trained for the modules in 'Education in Universal Human Values' we could sign a Memorandum of Understanding with Baha'i Academy also so that our students and other nearby institutions will also benefit in many ways.
- Dr. Dave told the IQAC that as discussed in the previous meetings, an MoU with K.M.E. society's Momin College was signed on 1st Dec. 2018 for mutual benefit of both institutes.
- Students will be taken to Homi Bhabha Centre for Science Education on the occasion of Science day 28th February, 2019 to give exposure to the students on various activities and information in Science.
 - It was decided that portfolio in-charge teachers must think of different places where students can be taken for educational field visits and gain enriching experiences.
- Teachers must train the students to make spoken tutorials in their methods so that ICT can be used in teaching learning by the student-teachers also. It was decided that students will prepare a 4-5 minute spoken tutorial to learn the process and upload their video on Edmodo.
