The IQAC members joined the meeting on Google Meet at 4:00 p.m. Dr. Bhavna Dave welcomed everyone and read the minutes of the last meeting held on 5th Jan. 2021.

Principal Dr. Sally Enos began by saying that due to late admissions, Sem.1 had just got over and therefore the CDC has planned orientation to Sem.2 for B.Ed. & M. Ed. in the next week. The timetables for conducting lectures for theory subjects have been prepared and shared with the teachers well in advance.

She added that every year additional workshops were conducted to train the students in skills in teaching before they planned full-fledged teaching lessons, however comprehensive training as a whole could be given which would involve various micro-skills, models of teaching, experiential teaching and other innovative teaching-learning strategies. The IQAC suggested that since all this was beyond the curriculum it could be converted into a value added course in 'Skills in Teaching' and offered to the students as a certificate course with minimum 30 credits. The decision was taken unanimously and work was distributed to get the brochure, course content and certificate ready for the same.

Internship had to be continued online for which permission had to be sought from the school Principals. As practice teaching in-charge, Dr. Geeta Thakur was requested to draft letters and seek permission for online internship to be carried out for Semester-2 in the month of July and August. Dr. Geeta said that the students have taken a certificate course in Digital Skills and therefore they would be able to carry out their internship smoothly.

IQAC Coordinator Dr. Bhavna Dave told the members that AQAR for the academic year 2018-19 was submitted on 19th May, 2021 and preparation for the next academic year 2019-2020 is in process. She added that data templates for the quantitative metrics have to be filled and the work has been distributed among the concerned faculty members as per their portfolios. The alumni members in the committee agreed to give data required for AQAR and also suggest quality initiatives that could be



conducted online keeping the current situation in mind. The NAAC sponsored webinar conducted from 3rd to 5th Feb.2021 gave a lot of clarity on the documentation required to be maintained with respect to the quantitative and qualitative metrics in the different criteria. The meeting then ended with a vote of thanks.

The IQAC online meeting began at 4:00 p.m. on Google Meet. Dr. Sally Enos informed everyone that Mrs. Bindu Tambe had resigned as faculty of the college. She welcomed Dr. Saramma Mathew in the committee & introduced her to the IQAC members. Thereafter, Dr. Bhavna Dave greeted everyone and read the minutes of the last meeting. Everyone unanimously confirmed the minutes.

She informed the IQAC members that as per the instructions of the University, the UoM sem 2 exams were conducted successfully from 6th Oct. to 9th Oct. 2021.

Practice-teaching incharge, Dr. Geeta Thakur said that she had sought permission from the school Principals & the activities of Semester-3 which has 11 weeks of Internship had begun from 20th Oct. 2021. The students had completed the value added certificate course on Skills in Teaching and were ready to prepare lessons and execute them effectively during internship.

Dr. Sally Enos proposed that a new value-added certificate course on Drama and Art in Education should be created. The IQAC members agreed saying that the NEP 2020 has also emphasized on integrating art with school teaching. Students need to be trained in this aspect. A team was formed to discuss the structure, duration and create the course content and brochure for the same. It was decided that the IQAC members can review and finalise the details of the course and the date of introduction.

The IQAC members discussed that Project-based courses for coming new batch 2021-2023 will be taken offline and therefore NGO centres preferably related to education will have to be identified in and around Navi Mumbai where Community work can be carried out. Student groups can be formed as per their place of stay and sent to the community centres with a mentor teacher.



IQAC members suggested that the teachers should apply for CAS. Dr. Sally Enos informed everyone that CAS application was to be done online now and all eligible teachers of the college should gather the details of their professional growth and apply for CAS. The teachers will feel motivated if they are promoted to the next level.

Dr. Bhavna Dave then proposed the vote of thanks to all the IQAC members.
