On the subsequent days children were instigated about the concepts of team building, concentration, co-ordination, effective communication skills, enhancing conversation skills through various games and presentations wherein the children could unfold their talent and skill in an effectual manner. They were acquainted with the commands, directions and songs taught by the instructor.

- Multiple stroke workshop and Warli painting was taught to the children by Mrs. Sonal Shah (Resource person). The workshop was quite thrilling as it involved giving strokes by dipping their fingers in the colours; the whole experience was that of playing Holi.



- Pencil strokes and pencil shading and Photo frame making activities were carried out by Mrs.Devanshi.



- Stain Glass painting and Paper quilling was taught to them by Mrs. Manisha Saxena(Resource person).The children as well as the teachers were engrossed and excited in learning the art of Paper- quilling. They designed beautiful message cards under the guidance of the instructor.



- Facial art and Egyptian art of writing was taught to them by Mrs. Bharti Iyer. Egyptian art involved the ancient style of writing; wherein symbols were used instead of the English alphabets. It started with Around the world activity wherein the children were educated about the continents of the world their area, population important countries, Capitals, Flags, currency and other important information about the major countries of the world.

Prepositions and Adjectives were taught to them through picture dictation. Practice worksheets enabled them to get accustomed to the concepts. On evaluation it was surprising to learn that most of them were very clear with the concept.

Homophones were taught to them through miming activity. The children were asked to participate for the same and it turned out to be a fun filled activity.

Maths topics such as basic operations and tables were made trouble-free through the activities; Cross-tots, Time bound tests, Fun with

Maths, Puzzles etc. Worksheets were provided to the children for the same.

The concept of Hydro-electricity was explained and the children were asked to represent the same in the form of a diagram. The activity reminded them of the movie 'Swades' and spontaneously the discussion on love for motherland were raised.

- A session was conducted for the students of Aniket on the basics of first aid by Mrs. Bindu Tambe. There were various situations created through storytelling using Suppandi as the main character.
