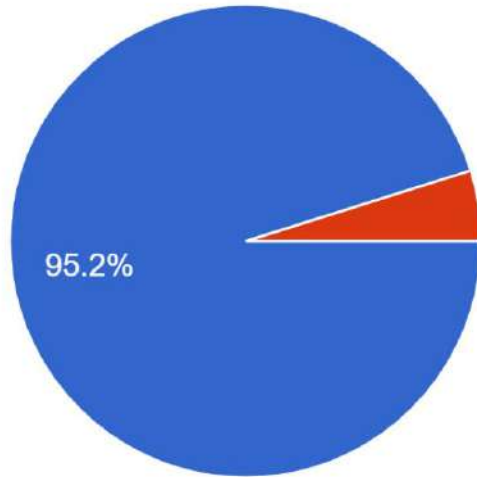

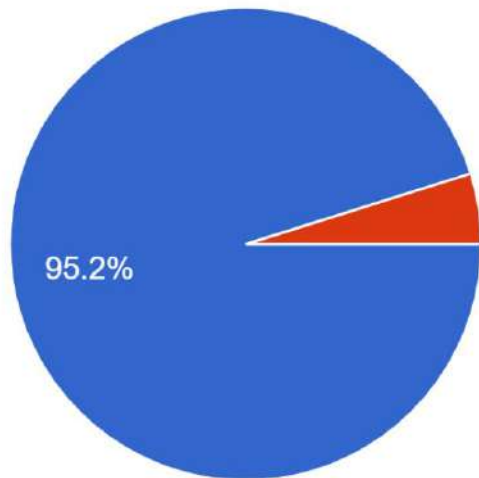

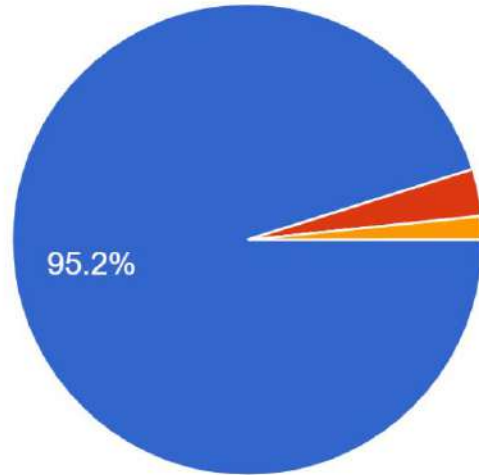

1. When you joined college, were you oriented about expectation from you and the competencies you should develop on completion of the Programme?

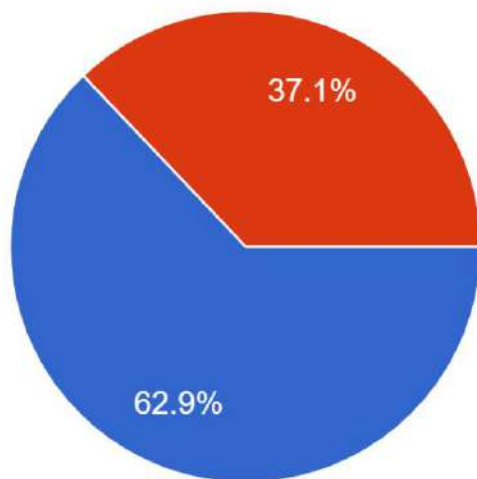

2. The Theory courses during B.Ed. / M.Ed. helped you become aware of the way school system works in the country.

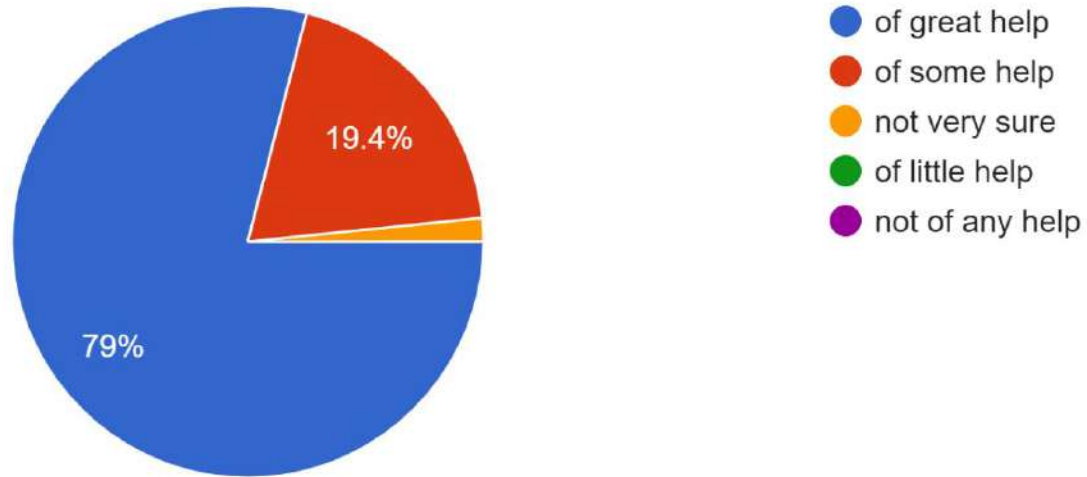

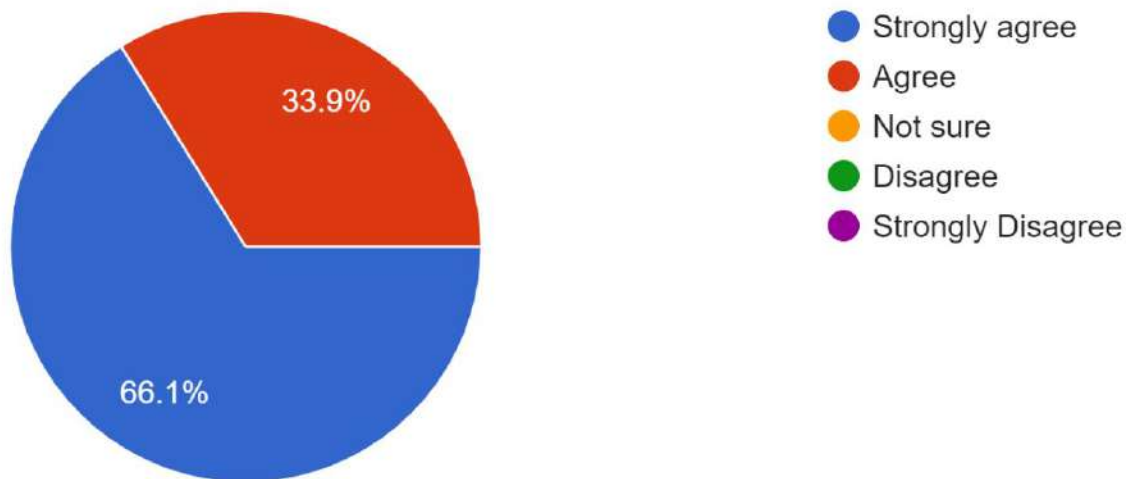

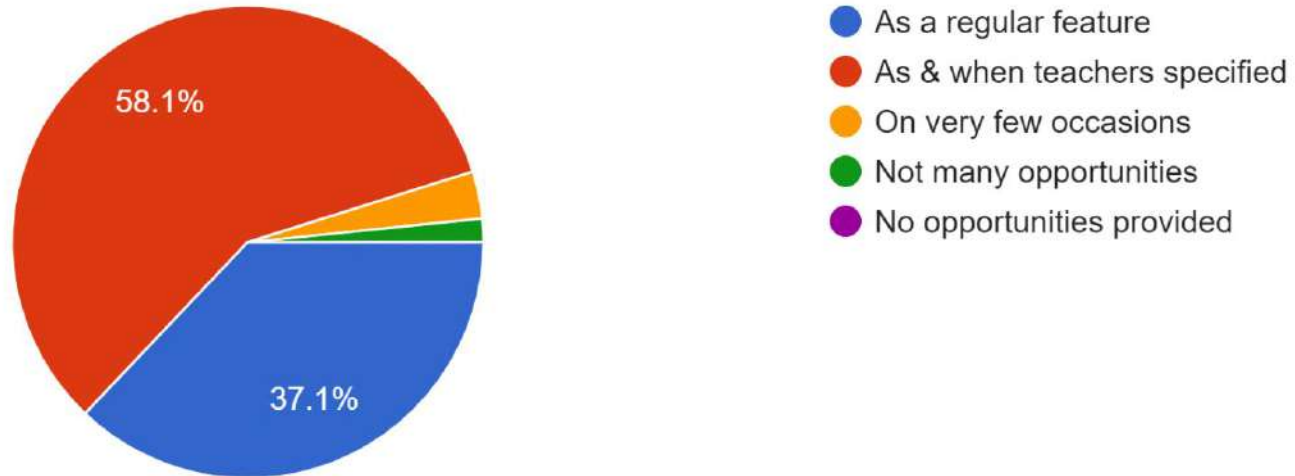

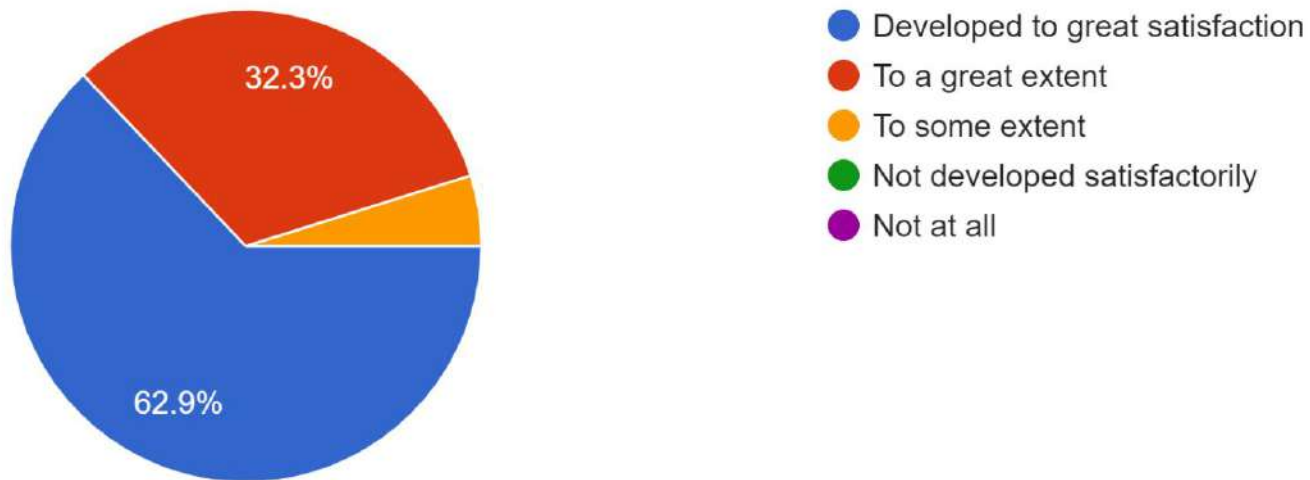

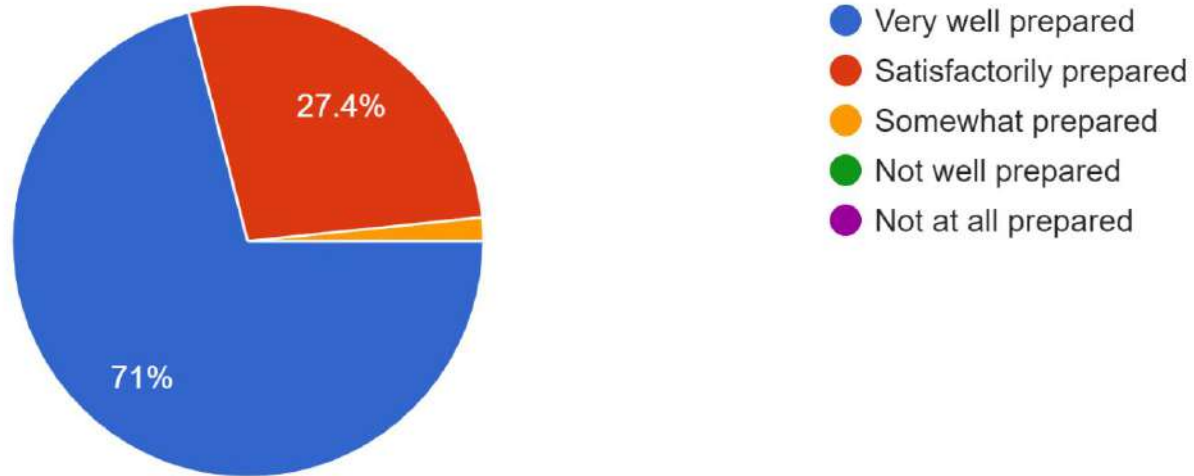

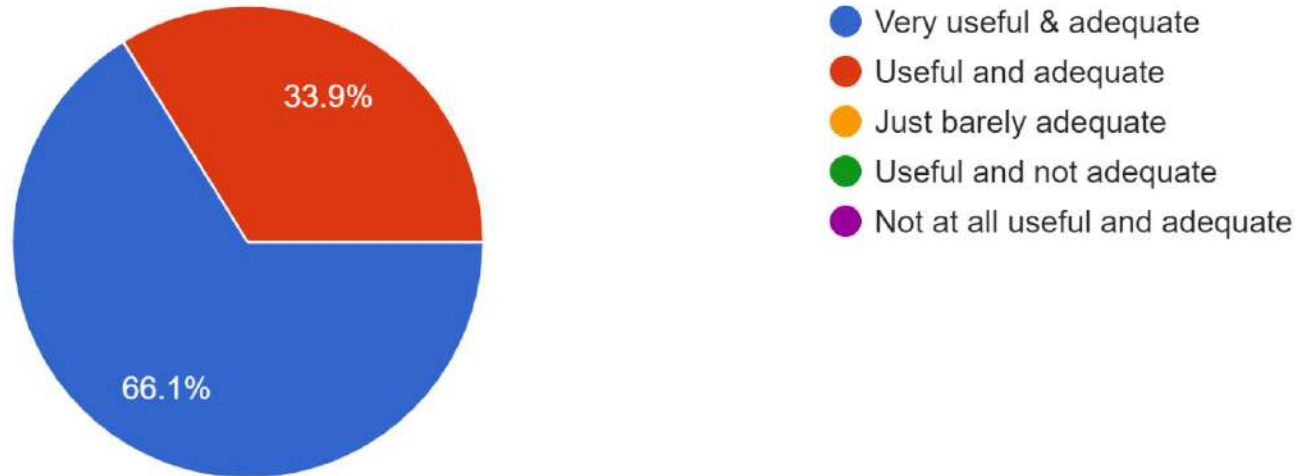

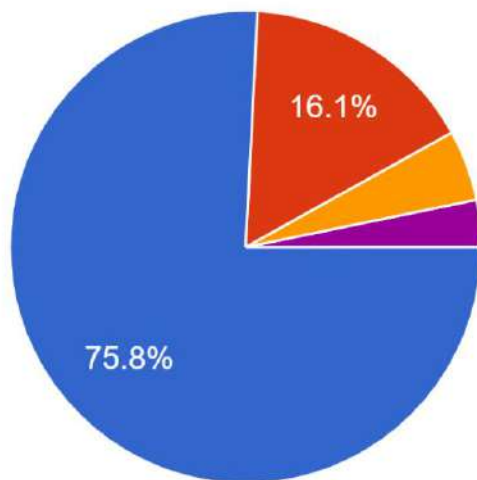

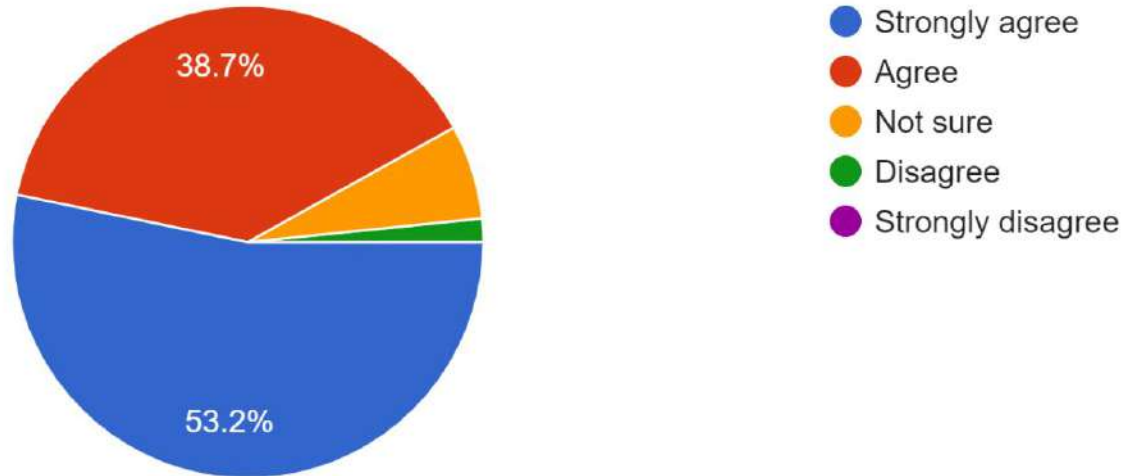

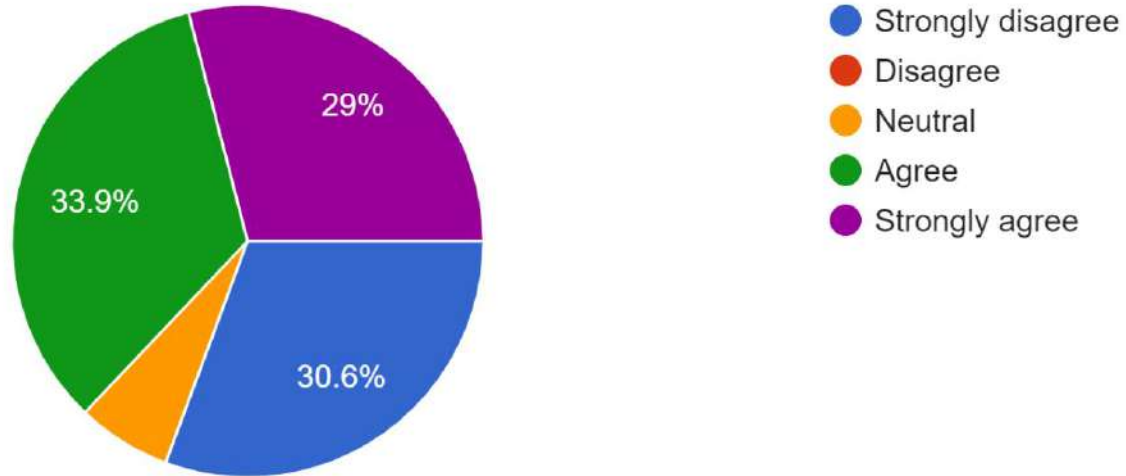

## 12. Overall qualities of teaching-learning and evaluation processes in the college are good.

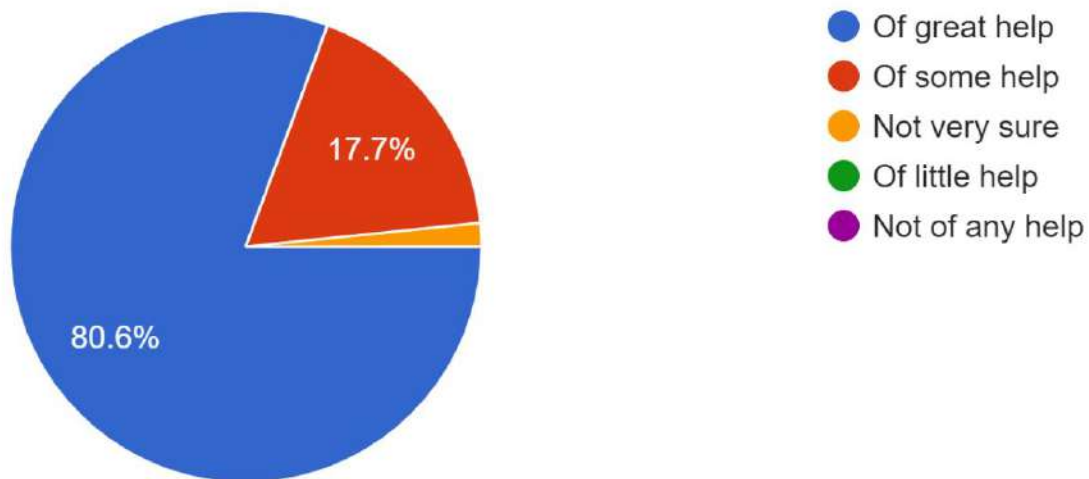
